Report	Background Information
	Sturgeon County has consistently placed value on the contributions Boards and Committees make toward strengthening our local governance and ensuring citizens are engaged as active participants in municipal governance, by representing the broader community.
	The Community Service Advisory Board Terms of Reference has not been reviewed since 2014.
	The recommended Terms of Reference does not contemplate any material changes in roles and responsibilities.
	 Changes that include membership from Edmonton Garrison and communication outside of meeting through the chair have been removed to reflect current practice.
	• Content that was removed to ensure consistency with the Bylaw included: Mayor as ex-officio, effective date of the term, appointment of Council Members and remuneration.
	 One change of note regarding the role of members to be available to represent the needs and interest of the division, by connecting with community associations is noteworthy. The Board members expressed their interest in expanding their role, as representatives of a division, to be leaders and support other organizations within their division as required. New Terms of Reference provides some additional clarity between the
	role of the Chair (Board Member) and Facilitator (Administration).
