Request for Decision

Title	Refund of 2015 and 2016 Taxes	5		
Proposed Motion	 That Council approve the refund of the 2015 property taxes and penalties for Roll # 4826000 in the amount of \$756.88. That Council approve the refund of half of 2016 property taxes for Roll # 4826000 in the amount of \$183.77. 			
Administrative Recommendation	Administration recommends the refund of 2015 property taxes and penalties and half of 2016 property taxes for this property.			
Previous Council Direction	No previous Council decisions r	elated to this property.		
Report	 Background Information On January 22, 2015, the resident's property was damaged by fire. In 2015 Council refunded taxes for a resident in the same neighborhood affected by the same fire who had applied for tax relief. Sturgeon County's fire department investigation report (File # 01-15-0008) indicates that about 12 homes sustained damages by this fire incident and the fire was started on the resident's property. In October 2017 Councillor Bokenfohr advised the finance department of the resident's interest in applying for tax exclusion. Sturgeon County's Finance Department made contact with the resident and advised that a letter requesting tax exclusion from Council be submitted in order to commence the process. On November 3, 2017 we received correspondence from the resident requesting tax relief and a refund of the taxes from 2015. As the fire damage occurred on January 22, 2015, near the beginning of the year; rather than prorating the amount, Administration is recommending the full year to be refunded. 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- Two (2) tax penalties were applied on July 1, 2015 and August 1, 2015 to the property tax owing on June 30, 2015. Administration is recommending that these be refunded as well, considering this would have occurred during the time when the resident would have lived outside of their home.
- 2016 taxes were reduced to \$365.55 reflecting the reduction in assessed value of the property. There were no penalties applied in 2016 as taxes were paid on time.

 The resident's building permit for the new residence was completed in July 2016, therefore Administration recommends waiving 50% of the 2016 taxes.

Alternatives Considered

- 1. That Council reject the waiving of the taxes.
- 2. That Council cancel only the municipal taxes, not the Seniors Housing and Education requisitions.

• The resident will be notified by letter of Council's decision. The property taxes and penalties owing will be adjusted accordingly.

Financial:

• Alternative 1 would see tax revenue stay the same.

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- Alternative 2 would see tax revenues decrease by \$622.71.
- In all alternatives, Administration recommends that the penalty be waived given the circumstances.

Follow up Action

1. The resident will be notified by letter of Council's decision. The property taxes and penalties waived will be credited to Roll# 4826000 based on Council's decision.
