Report	Background Information
	In 2016, Sturgeon County undertook a review of the Local Road
	Reconstruction Program to determine whether gravel road construction
	should be undertaken by Sturgeon County resources or by contracted
	services.
	The results of the review and subsequent approval of Council saw the
	delivery of this important program shift from Sturgeon County forces to
	externally contracted services, managed by the Engineering Services
	Department.

- is well-positioned to deliver a new \$4 million annual road reconstruction program.
- Sturgeon County Council identified the Local Roads Reconstruction Program as a Corporate Initiative for 2017-2019 in its Corporate Business Plan. The project has been broken into multiple sub-projects to complete.
- On February 28, 2017, Council approved the additional funding required to award the contract of the Local Roads Reconstruction Program Design to Deloitte. Deloitte worked with Engineering Services and Transportation Services to complete the program design.
- Key points the Consultant addressed include (but are not limited to):
 - Reviewing Sturgeon County contract templates and provide improvements for 3-year contracts with 3-year options to renew, along with the ability to cancel based on quality control/assurance issues for Engineering and Construction;
 - Designing process to identify and evaluate a minimum of 12.8 km of roads to be constructed each year;
 - Utilizing the 10-year prioritized listing of Road Project Candidates recommended by Sturgeon County and facilitated a workshop with Sturgeon County staff to prioritize the 10 years of road candidates into a 10-year plan using the vendor designed process;
 - Designing Quality Control and Quality Assurance measures evaluation tools;
 - Designing a Pre-qualification process;
 - Designing criteria for measuring Local Roads Reconstruction Program success;
 - Developing the timing/staging of activities in 2017-2019;
 - Identifying the Local Roads Reconstruction Program's required positions, including all aspects of project management including planning, executing, managing and controlling;
 - Developing a Roadmap to implement designed plan;
 - Utilizing documented Reconstruction Standards (width of roads) designed by Sturgeon County; and
 - Evaluating available budget against minimum 12.8km of roads to ensuring sufficient budget, and if not, propose additional funding requirements.

 Approving the hiring of positions over the summer in 2017 will allow Administration to have the program fully transitioned from Deloitte and able to move forward on Pre-Engineering activities earlier in 2018.

 The funding for the positions in 2017 would be taken from reserves (or Council could choose to approve additional funds and not absorb out of the current budget).
