Title	2017 Tax Recovery Reserve Bid
Proposed Motion	That Council approve the reserve bid identified in Appendix A at market value as prepared by the County Assessment Department, for the Public Tax Recovery Property Auction to be held on November 6, 2017.
Administrative Recommendation	That the Public Auction take place on November 6, 2017 with reserve prices representing market value as established.
Previous Council Direction	Previous Motion: October 25, 2016 – Motion 371/16: That Council approve the reserve bids identified in Appendix A at market value as prepared by the County Assessment department, for the Public Tax Recovery Property Auction to be held on November 21, 2016.
Report	 Background Information Sturgeon County Council annually approves reserve bids for Tax Recovery sale. The County Assessment Department prepares the Public Sale of Land Report to estimate the market value for the list of properties Sturgeon County will offer for sale, by public auction, in Council Chambers on Monday, November 6, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. The estimated market value of each property is listed in Appendix A. Property owners have up to the date and time of the public auction to pay tax arrears. External Communication The Public Sale of Land Report was advertised in the Alberta Gazette on September 15, 2017, and will be advertised in the Morinville Free Press on October 24, 2017. Relevant Policy/Legislation/Practices: Municipal Government Act, R.S.A 2000, c.M-26, Section 419, Reserve bid

Date Written: October 10, 2017 Council Meeting Date: October 24, 2017 For each parcel of land to be offered for sale at a public auction, Council must set

- (a) a reserve bid that is as close as reasonably possible to the market value of the parcel, and
- (b) any conditions that apply to the sale.

Administration will have information regarding the lowest possible bid acceptable at the November 6, 2017 tax recovery property sale.

Financial:

Sturgeon County is allowed to retain from sale proceeds the amount of tax arrears as well as a 5% administration fee.
