Report	Background Information			
	 Sturgeon School Division (SSD) officially registered their Lagoon with Alberta Environment and Parks (AEP) on June 12, 2015 (AEP Lic #: 0235925-00-00). At the December 9, 2015 SSD/Sturgeon County (SC) Joint Meeting, SSD Board and the County Council discuss a "fee for service" model that 			
	 would incorporate County Staff operating the Lagoon for SSD. April 22, 2016 – County Staff inspect the lagoon to determine its overal condition. The inspection indicates that the lagoon is healthy with good anaerobic activity. The inspection report also notes some opportunities for improvement. 			
	 September 29, 2016 – The County provides SSD with a one-year proposal that lists proposed work activities by both parties and maintenance schedule. 			
	October, 2016 – Review of agreement drafted by legal Counsel RMRF.			
	 November 2, 2016 – Agreement provided to SSD to for their review an comments. Awaiting approval from both parties.

Organizational:

- Entering into a one-year lagoon maintenance agreement with Sturgeon School Division will require two staff performing weekly inspections of the lagoon. Sturgeon County will also provide an annual report to AEP on behalf of the School Division to meet AEP's reporting requirements. These additional tasks can be completed as part of the current staff capacity.
- Berm and other required maintenance activities, such as vegetation management, will be performed by SSD's superintendent.

Financial:

• Sturgeon County Utilities will receive \$33,000 per year (plus GST) at full cost recovery to perform this work.

Alternatives Considered

Council could request Administration to look at other options for the Sturgeon School Division Lagoon.
