Proposed Motion	That Council authorize the Mayor, CAO and the County Fire Chief to ex the 2018-2020 Fire Services Agreement with the Summer Village of Sur Beach.			
Administrative Recommendation	Manager of Protective Services recommends that County Council authorizes the Mayor, CAO and the County Fire Chief to execute the 2018 – 2020 Fire Services Agreement with the Summer Village of Sunrise Beach.			
Previous Council Direction	January 13, 2015 Motion 004/15: That County Council authorizes the Mayor, CAO and County Fire Chief to sign and execute the Fire Services Agreement dated January 13, 2015 with the Summer Village of Sunrise Beach.			
	July 30, 1987 Motion 671/87: Moved by Councillor Everitt that the Reeve and Administrator be authorized to sign the proposed mutual aid agreement with the Summer Village of Sandy Beach.			
Report	Background Information			
	• The current Fire Service Agreement that is in place was endorsed in early 2015 and expires at the end of 2017.			
	• Prior to the current agreement, the County provided fire services to the Village from 1987 concluding in 2009.			
	• In the spring of 2013, the CAO for the Summer Village of Sunrise Beach ("the Village") contacted administration and expressed interest in returning to a fire service agreement once again that would see the County provide fire services to the Village.			
	 Negotiations for this new agreement took place over a few months with all parties involved working together to ensure a new agreement was equitable and defined service level expectations. 			
	 As a result, in early 2015, a three-year agreement was approved that permitted fire and rescue services to Village residents by County Protective Services, Fire Department. 			
	The agreement and motion before Council today is a new agreement that would see fire and rescue services continue to be provided by the County			

Date Written: October 18, 2017 Council Meeting Date: November 28, 2017 Protective Services, Fire Department for the next three years, becoming effective January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2020.

- Services in relation to this agreement will primarily be provided by the
 District of Calahoo Fire and Morinville Fire Departments. In reviewing past
 call volumes, it is anticipated that the Village on average will require
 services 10-12 times per year. These additional calls will not impact
 services levels within the County.
- The Village Council endorsed this new agreement on October 4, 2017.

 This is primarily an operational matter that may be communicated by public media, and individual Councilor mentions to the residents of Sunrise Beach.

This agreement ensures sustainability fire and rescue services for the Village and provides the County the opportunity to collaborate and recognize the need of one its neighbors. A fulfilling relationship with the Village's residents has been in place for many years. This agreement builds on that relationship.

This agreement is a fee-for-services arrangement. All fees and invoicing will be maintained within the County Protective Services Budget.
