Title	Request to Waive Tax Penalty			
Proposed Motion	That Council adhere to Policy ADM-Tax-2 and deny the request to waive the tax penalty related to Roll 1800.80.

Direction	Council gave third reading to Bylaw 1366/16 2016 Taxation Rates.			
Report	 Sturgeon County municipal taxes are due the last working day of June every year. County residents are made aware of this date as it is provided on their tax notices annually and also posted on Sturgeon's County Website. Payments for 2016 must be postmarked on or before June 30 or received at Sturgeon County Centre before the end of business, 4:30 p.m. on June 30 to avoid penalty charges. Late penalty charges for the 2016 tax year are as follows: 6% of current levy July 1, 2016 6% of current levy August 1, 2016 12% of total owing March 1, 2017. There are 23 roll numbers with Fort McMurray addresses in the 2016 taxation year and out of this number, 3 remain unpaid with penalties. Tax penalties are in place to ensure timely payment of property taxes. The County offers a Tax Installment Payment Plan (TIPP) that allows property owners in Sturgeon County to pay their property tax in monthly installments throughout the year rather than a single payment. The intent is to break residents' property taxes into more manageable amounts, making it easier to budget and ensure taxes are paid on time. On September 7, 2016, Administration received a request from a taxpayer to make a presentation to Council requesting a refund of the tax penalty of \$316.78 issued on roll # 1800.80 The amount represents penalties levied on July 1 and August 1 of 2016. The taxpayer indicates an inability to make arrangements to pay the taxes owing on time due to a delay in mail forwarding to their new address after the fires in Fort McMurray, Alberta, that started May 2, 2016.

- County Council, at its discretion, may waive property taxes or any associated penalties however Administration is recommending against that option to ensure consistency.

Relevant Policy/Legislation/Practices:

- Section 344 of the *Municipal Government Act* provides for Council to impose a penalty for non-payment of taxes in the current year.
- Policy ADM-Tax-2: Tax penalties will not for any reason be cancelled unless a proven human or machine error is made by Sturgeon County staff.
- Penalties on Unpaid Municipal Taxes Bylaw 805/95
- Following the June 2013 Flooding in Calgary and southern Alberta, there
 was a directive from Minister of Municipal Affairs to provide leniency on
 payment of taxes and penalties. No such advice has been received from
 Municipal Affairs.
