The previously scheduled dates for the 2018 Budget meetings were approved by Council at the October 24, 2017 Organizational Meeting; however, those dates were cancelled on November 29, 2017.

As required by the Municipal Government Act, Council must set an operating budget for each calendar year or may pass an interim budget by December 31st.

Relevant Policy/Legislation/Practices:

Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000 c.M-26 Section 193

A Council may decide at a Council meeting at which all members are present, the dates, times and location of regularly scheduled Council meetings.

Section 242

- (1) Each council must adopt an operating budget for each calendar year.
- (2) A council may adopt an interim operating budget for part of a calendar year.
- (3) An interim operating budget for a part of a calendar year ceases to have any effect when the operating budget for that calendar year is adopted.

Implication of Administrative Recommendation

Strategic Alignment:

Strong Local Governance and Regional Leadership

In order to align with the Strategic Plan and adhere to legislative requirements a budget must be approved by Council for the future year.

Organizational:

An approved budget allows the organization to provide service levels to Sturgeon County Residents.

Financial:

Financial implications are contingent on Council budget decisions.

Alternatives Considered

Council could choose to not approve the recommended dates and times, or could choose different dates, however, then Council must approve an interim operating budget.

Implications of In the absence of an approved budget, the interim budget is a requirement **Alternatives** of the *Municipal Government Act*.
