Title 11:30 a.m. – Town of Bon Accord Annexation Application **Proposed Motion** 1. That Council authorize the Mayor to sign the Agreement Regarding Highway 28 Service Road as presented. 2. That Council authorize the Mayor to sign the Town of Bon Accord's Annexation Application and Negotiating Report, to send to the Municipal Government Board, on behalf of Sturgeon County Council, pending the Town of Bon Accord's endorsement of the Highway Service Road Agreement. Administrative That Council sign the Negotiation Report, and not contest the proposed Recommendation annexation by the Town of Bon Accord. **Previous Council** November 24, 2015 - Motion 377/15 Direction That Sturgeon County Council approves the Sturgeon County Annexation Principles (Attachment #1) and use them as the starting point in future annexation discussions, and remain private in accordance with Section 197 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, C-M-26, as amended. C.F-25, as amended. **Report** | Background Information On March 7, 2016, Sturgeon County received official notice from the Town of Bon Accord indicating their intent to annex three (3) quarter sections of land from Sturgeon County. Specifically, the lands in question are: SE 13-56-24-W4; o NE 13-56-24-W4; and

o NW 18-56-23-W4.

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- Their intent indicated a scope change from the initial notice provided September 29, 2015, whereby the Town intended to only annex a single quarter section at that point in time.
- Sturgeon County Council appointed two (2) members of Council to the Negotiating Committee with the Town of Bon Accord, and established Annexation Principles in 2015 to guide annexation negotiations from a County perspective.
- Having gone through negotiations and landowner consultations, the
 Town of Bon Accord is now prepared to send its final report to the
 Municipal Government Board (MGB) to make a recommendation on its
 proposal. The Town is seeking Sturgeon County Council's endorsement
 of the report and agreement not to contest the annexation, to form this
 submission.

External Communication

- The Town of Bon Accord has been responsible for external communications and landowner negotiations, as prescribed by the MGA and determined by the Negotiating Committee.
- Once the Negotiation Report is provided to the MGB, the MGB will advertise the proposed annexation.
- Details of the Negotiating Committee's discussions have remained private, until the release of the Negotiation Report to the MGB to both Councils.

Implication of Administrative Recommendation

Strategic Alignment:

Strong Local Governance and Regional Leadership – Recognizing that the Town of Bon Accord has long-term growth aspirations, and that County Council wishes to work with our neighbours to achieve regional growth, the proposed direction is consistent with this Focus Area, given that the County's Annexation Principles have been addressed.

Planned Growth – While the Town of Bon Accord's population has decreased in recent years, the additional land supply allows the Town to contemplate the type of growth envisioned by the Edmonton Metropolitan Regional Growth Plan and to work towards their respective population projections. Should the annexation be successful, the new boundaries will provide long-term planning certainty to the municipalities, developers, and residents.

Organizational:

Some staff time may be required to monitor and support the MGB's Public Hearing, if objections are received from the public.

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Financial:

The three (3) quarter sections proposed for annexation account for slightly less than \$7,000 a year in taxes; road maintenance costs to the County are estimated at \$12,500, representing a potential cost-savings of \$5,500 per year.

The Negotiating Committee has agreed to long-term assessment and tax protection for a period of twenty (20) years, or until a trigger is activated that would change this (i.e. subdivision or rezoning at request of landowner).

Alternatives Considered

Council may choose not to sign the application nor report, and to contest the annexation.

Implications of Alternatives

Strategic Alignment:

 Contesting the annexation would run counter to the discussions negotiated in good faith by the Negotiating Committee, and would likely result in strained relations between the Town of Bon Accord and Sturgeon County Councils, who have been open and collaborative todate.

Organizational:

 Contesting the annexation may require legal fees and staff resources, previously unplanned for.

Financial:

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Follow up Action

1. Administration will coordinate with the Mayor to sign and submit the proper documentation as required (Intergovernmental Affairs, June 2017).
