Report	<ul> <li>Background Information</li> <li>The distinguished budget award is designed to ensure an entity's budget serves as a policy document, a financial plan, an operations guide and a communications device.</li> <li>The award review ensures that the budget document is fully transparent to our stakeholders and in an easy-to-read format.</li> <li>The budget document is a tool that is used to communicate with all stakeholders where Sturgeon County is coming from and what we plan to achieve and the plan to get there.</li> <li>2017 is the second year that Sturgeon County had submitted its consolidated budget package to GFOA (Government Finance Officers Association) for review.</li> <li>The criteria that must be fulfilled when applying for the award includes: <ul> <li>Strategic Goals and Strategies;</li> <li>Organization Priorities and Issues;</li> <li>Budget Overview;</li> <li>Budget Transparency;</li> <li>Basis for Budgeting/Budget Process;</li> <li>Financial Policies;</li> <li>Performance Measures; and</li> <li>Statistics and Supplementary Data.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

- The budget is reviewed by three independent committee members, and a consolidated ranking is used to determine the overall score of the budget document that has been submitted. Reviewers provide feedback and identify opportunities for improvement which are incorporated in subsequent years.
- The Distinguished Budget Award is open to municipalities, colleges and School Districts within Canada and the United States of America. (Note: The list of municipalities that received recognition in 2017 was not available at time of approval of the Agenda and, where possible, will be brought forward to the October 24, 2017 Council Meeting)
- Collaboration amongst every department was key to bringing the 2017 budget package together; however, special recognition to Financial Services, Communications and Business Strategy is due for the success of the document.
- Part of the success with the 2017 budget package was the complete revision of the budget document in 2016. From the feedback that was received from the peer reviewers, we expanded our 2017 budget package to include our 10-Year Strategic Plan.
