## **Request for Decision**

## Title Rural Municipalities of Alberta (RMA) Resolution re: Provincial Highway **Access and Setback Authority Proposed Motion** 1. That Council endorse the proposed Rural Municipalities of Alberta resolution, provided as Attachment 2, for consideration at the October 7, 2019 Pembina River Zone Meeting. 2. That Council appoint Councillor Bokenfohr as the Resolution Champion for the October 7, 2019 Pembina River Zone Meeting and any further reviews. Administrative Administration recommends that Councillor Bokenfohr bring the attached Recommendation Rural Municipalities of Alberta (RMA) resolution forward, for Council's support. **Previous Council** June 25, 2019 – Motion 246/19: Direction That Council direct Administration to engage Alberta Transportation to remove roadway setbacks of 800 metres as it restricts businesses throughout Alberta. Report **Background Information** At the June 25, 2019 regular Council meeting, Council directed Administration to engage with Alberta Transportation regarding 800metre roadway setback requirements.

- Following the meeting, Councillor Bokenfohr expressed a desire to bring the matter forward as a resolution at the October 2019 RMA Zone meeting for consideration, with additional context on road access as
  - well.
- A suggested resolution is attached for Council's consideration. The resolution advocates that:
  - "The Rural Municipalities of Alberta engage with Alberta Transportation to reduce red tape that limits rural development or economic potential, through a delegation of additional authority to municipalities to regulate provincial highway access and setback requirements, and a review of the provincial framework in this area to reflect best practices from jurisdictions across Canada."
- Should Council approve the resolution, Administration recommends that Council appoint Councillor Bokenfohr as the Resolution Champion,

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meaning that he would be responsible for speaking to the resolution at the Pembina River Zone Meeting and ensuring that a seconder for the resolution is secured.

### **External Communication**

 The resolution will be shared with the RMA, through its Pembina Zone meeting.

## Relevant Policy/Legislation/Practices:

• The resolution format aligns with the RMA's requirements and there is no specific legislation that dictates format or content.

## Implication of Administrative Recommendation

## Strategic Alignment:

a missed opportunity in this regard.

 Appointment of a different Resolution Champion would require that individual to familiarize themselves with the issue and present as required.
