Request for Decision

Title **Distribution of Community Services Capital Budget to Neighbourhood Parks Proposed Motion** That Council approve the distribution of the Community Services 2017 Capital Budget in the amount of \$100,000.00 in the following manner: * \$47,000 to Manor Estates outdoor skating; * \$20,000 for Signage at Sandy Lake; and * \$33,000 remain unallocated in the reserve. Administrative Administration supports the motion and values the contributions of the Recommendation volunteers in our community who are invested in making their communities great places to live. **Previous Council** December 13, 2016 - Motion 455/16: Direction That Council approve the 2017 Operating and Capital Budget as presented in the 2017 Budget Document. **Background Information** Report

- Community Services' Capital Budget contains funding for a combination of direct County-managed and Community-sponsored collaborative projects.
 - County-managed projects are typically on county-wide parks, greenways and natural areas.
 - Community sponsored projects on both neighbourhood and local open spaces are highly dependent on community volunteers who project manage the developments on Municipal Reserve.
- Historically, the capital budget allocations for community projects have been deferred year over year due to delays in community readiness to proceed.
- To align the <u>Open Space Master Plan</u> and the Community Services Capital Budget the specific site references were removed from the Budget.
- Based on the efforts of the community volunteers and the desire to systematically and progressively improve our open space system Administration recommends support for the following two projects in 2017:
 - Manor Estates rink
 - Community volunteer has been flooding and clearing the rink at his own expense.

- The asphalt surface has not been maintained and flooding is very difficult
- The development contemplated within this funding request is consistent with our intent to serve the local residents within a walkable distance, and park features are typically limited to a small number of amenities that accommodate local preferences for passive and social activities.
- The estimate includes both rink boards and asphalt surface.
- Sandy Lake Signage
 - Plans for the protection of Sandy Lake have been contemplated since the approval of the original Open Space Master Plan in 2004
 - Signage and public information is an important the first step in creating the necessary awareness of this natural area and our desire to protect it.
 - There will be a total of four signs installed. Cost includes the design, materials, fabrication and installation
 - Sign size will be 17.5 inches by 60 inches installed on a single post.
- Future projects may include playground features in Carbondale,
 playground in Riverstone Pointe and park development in Pinewood.

External Communication

There has been no external communication regarding the recommendation.

Relevant Policy/Legislation/Practices:

• This is a new practice for designating funding for community based projects to support transparency and consistency in process.

Implication of Administrative Recommendation

Strategic Alignment:

Respect the Natural Environment – Sturgeon County has been committed to put the necessary plans in place to protect our natural areas like Sandy Lake.

Maintain and Enhance Strong Communities – Sturgeon County has consistently supported the efforts of our volunteers. Working collaboratively with the residents in Manor Estates will ensure we are effectively meeting the local needs.

Organizational:

The organizational impacts are minimal. The work had been planned.

Financial:

Funding was approved as part of the budget process in the absence of any specific site plans. Uncommitted funds will remain in reserves.

Strategic Alignment:
