Administrative Recommendation	Administration recommends that Council support and promotes volunteerism in Sturgeon County through the cancellation of property taxes for Riverlot 56 Natural Area Society.

Report	<ul> <li>Riverlot 56 Natural Area Society is a not-for-profit organization.</li> <li>Current taxes amount to \$264.75.</li> <li>Taxes for previous three years: 2017 - \$263.95; 2016 - \$265.93; 2015 - \$262.31.</li> <li>Since 1973, local groups have recognized the value of the site and have worked to ensure that Riverlot 56 is maintained as a natural setting for outdoor education and recreation.</li> <li>The Riverlot 56 Natural Area Society was formed in 1980 and granted a lease to manage the site as a "Natural Area". Its goal is to preserve the physical and ecological diversity of the area while promoting nature-oriented educational and recreational activities.</li> <li>The site received a designation of protection by the Canadian Council on Ecological Areas in 1987 and is a protected area.</li> </ul>
