### Organizational:

 Hawkings Epp Dumont LLP has a good detailed knowledge of Sturgeon County systems and processes. Appointing a new auditor would take staff time to complete requests for quotes and evaluations, as well new auditors would take more time to learn the system and create a less efficient audit.

# Financial:

 Hawkings Epp Dumont LLP audit fees are competitive; selecting a new auditor would not guaranty a reduced fee.
