# **Request for Decision**

## Title 11:45 a.m. – Town of Gibbons Annexation Application **Proposed Motion** 1. That Council authorize the Mayor to sign the Range Road 231 Agreement as presented. 2. That Council authorize the Mayor to sign the Town of Gibbons' Annexation Application Report, to send to the Municipal Government Board, on behalf of Sturgeon County Council. Administrative That Council approve the Annexation Report, and not contest the proposed Recommendation annexation by the Town of Gibbons. **Previous Council** November 24, 2015 – Motion 377/15 Direction That Sturgeon County Council approves the Sturgeon County Annexation Principles (Attachment #1) and use them as the starting point in future annexation discussions, and remain in private in accordance with Section 197 of the Municipal Government Act, RSA. 2000, c.M-26, as amended. September 23, 2014 – Motion 290/14 That Council establishes an ad hoc Gibbons Annexation Negotiating Committee consisting of the Mayor, Division 6 Councillor and the County Commissioner or appropriate designates. September 23, 2014 - Motion 289/14 That Council authorizes Administration to advise the Town of Gibbons that Sturgeon County will participate in annexation discussions. **Background Information** Report On September 24, 2013, Council received official notice from the Town of Gibbons indicating their intent to annex three (3) quarter sections of land from Sturgeon County. Specifically, the subject lands include: o SW-11-56-23-W4; o NW-2-56-23-W4; and, o SW-2-56-23-W4. Following receipt of the Intent to Annex lands within Sturgeon County, Council appointed two (2) members of Council to the Negotiating Committee with the Town of Gibbons, and established annexation principles in 2015 to guide annexation negotiations from the County's

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perspective.

- Having gone through negotiations and landowner consultations, the
  Town of Gibbons is now prepared to send its final report to the
  Municipal Government Board (MGB) to make a recommendation on its
  proposal. The Town is seeking Council's endorsement of the report, and
  agreement not to contest the annexation to form this submission.
- Through negotiations, the Town of Gibbons has proposed no compensation be awarded to Sturgeon County for lost revenues given that they account for less than \$10,000/year, and given other agreements, which are seen as positive outcomes for both municipalities:
  - The proposed sanitary system will be designed to service the adjacent country residential communities of Casa Vista, Riverside Park, and Sierra Ridge;
  - The Town will not seek any further annexations from Sturgeon County for at least thirty (30) years; and
  - The Town will be responsible for enhancing Range Road 231 within Sturgeon County's jurisdiction, to an industrial standard as development occurs within the annexed lands.
- Further, the Town has proposed that tax protections will be in place for twenty-five (25 years) to lessen the impacts of the annexation on impacted landowners, whereby the properties will be assessed and taxed by the Town at the same rate as Sturgeon County, or their own (whichever is lower).
- Only when a portion of the annexed land becomes a new parcel of land as result of subdivision, or separation of title by registered plan or subdivision, or is redistricted at the request of the landowner, or ceases to be used as farmland/a development permit is issued, is the tax protection lost, should one of these triggering events occur.

## **External Communication**

- The Town of Gibbons has been responsible for external communications and landowner negotiations, as prescribed by the MGA and determined by the Negotiating Committee.
- Open Houses on the annexation were held on March 16, 2016 and on June 7, 2017.
- Once the Negotiation Report is provided to the MGB, the MGB will advertise the proposed annexation.
- Details of the Negotiating Committee's discussions have remained private, until the release of the Negotiation Report to the MGB and to both Councils.

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## Implication of Administrative Recommendation

#### Strategic Alignment:

**Strong Local Governance and Regional Leadership** – Recognizing that the Town of Gibbons has long-term growth aspirations, and that County Council wishes to work with their neighbour to achieve regional growth, the proposed direction is consistent with this Focus Area, given that the County's Annexation Principles have been addressed.

Planned Growth and Prosperity – The additional land supply allows the Town to contemplate the type of growth envisioned by the Edmonton Metropolitan Growth Plan, and to work towards their respective population projections and a more balanced residential/non-residential assessment base.

### Organizational:

Some staff time may be required to monitor and support the MGB's Public Hearing, if objections are received from the public.

#### Financial:

Sturgeon County collects approximately \$6,000 in tax revenue from the properties in question, including Residential, Farmland, and Linear revenues. The Town has agreed to long-term tax protection for impacted ratepayers, for a period of 25 years or until a trigger determines otherwise.

## Alternatives Considered

Council may choose to contest the annexation.

## Implications of Alternatives

#### Strategic Alignment:

 Contesting the annexation would run counter to the discussions and arrangements negotiated in good faith by the Negotiating Committee, and would likely result in strained relations between the Town of Gibbons and Sturgeon County Councils, who have been open and collaborative in discussions to date.

## Organizational:

• Contesting the annexation may require legal fees and significant unplanned staff resources.

## Financial:

 Contesting the annexation may require legal fees and unplanned staff resources.

#### **Follow up Action**

1. Administration will coordinate with the Mayor's Office to sign and submit the proper documentation as required (Intergovernmental Affairs, July 2017).
