Request for Decision

Title

Sturgeon County & Town of Morinville Agreement for Maintenance and Operation of Jointly Developed Infrastructure - Alberta Community Partnership Program Grant

Proposed Motion

- That Council support the development of an agreement between Town
 of Morinville and Sturgeon County for the maintenance and operation of
 jointly developed utilities and roads on the County Campus and
 Morinville Recreation lands.
- That Council authorize Administration to submit a joint grant application with Town of Morinville for 2016/2017 Alberta Community Partnership (ACP) grant program to develop a maintenance and operation of jointly developed infrastructure agreement.
- That Council designate Sturgeon County as the Managing Partner for the development of an agreement in accordance with the ACP grant application.

Administrative Recommendation

Administration recommends that Council support and authorize the development of an agreement between Town of Morinville and Sturgeon County. A Council motion supporting and authorizing the project is required under the ACP Program Grant.

Previous Council Direction

July 12, 2016 - Motion 253/16:

That Council authorizes the Mayor and the CAO to sign the Memorandum of Understanding for the Sharing of Costs for Site Servicing between the Town of Morinville and Sturgeon County.

March 8, 2016 - Motion 080/16:

That Council gives third reading of Debenture Bylaw 1359/15, as amended for the purpose of financing County Campus - Servicing with a maximum amount of \$5,000,000.

November 10, 2015 - Motion 353/15:

That Sturgeon County Council approves the purchase of the land at SE-2-56-25-W4, a 50-acre parcel, as stated in the Offer to Purchase.

Report

Background Information

- The purpose of this Request for Decision is to obtain a Council motion to support the grant application developing an agreement between Town of Morinville and Sturgeon County for the future operation and maintenance of shared utilities on the County Campus and Morinville Recreation lands.
- The Administrations of both Sturgeon County and the Town of Morinville are operating in a proactive manner to ensure a joint maintenance and operating agreement for the shared infrastructure (utilities and roads) is in place before operations commence.
- The Inter-Municipal Collaboration Component of the ACP Program supports projects that promotes inter-municipal land use and service delivery planning.
- As part of the ACP grant application, a Council resolution is required from each partner of the project. The resolution should confirm Council support for the project, authorize the submission of the application to the ACP program and designate a managing partner for the project.
- Administrations for the Town of Morinville and Sturgeon County formed a Joint Servicing Committee for the construction of shared infrastructure for adjacent properties (Recreational Facility and County Campus)
- The Joint Servicing Committee agreed to Terms of Reference, which included the development of a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to provide a framework for cost sharing of shared utility and infrastructure (roads) construction in an equitable manner.
- The construction cost-sharing MoU acknowledged that a future agreement will be necessary to detail the ownership, operation, and maintenance of the infrastructure developed by both municipalities.
- This new agreement will set out responsibilities for each municipality and how capital replacements funds and operational cost will be shared.
- Town of Morinville Council passed a similar motion on January 10, 2017 to support the grant application for the project.
- It is anticipated the agreement will be completed by August 2017.

• When the maintenance and operations agreement is developed, and signed, Corporate Communications will provide a news release.

Implication of Administrative Recommendation

Strategic Alignment:

Strong Local Governance and Regional Leadership –This cooperative approach sets a good example of regional cooperation in achieving Sturgeon County goals while reducing the overall costs.

Strong Local Governance and Regional Leadership – Developing the agreement for facilities maintenance and operations shows the County's ability to execute planned work that is important to the County and its residents.

Organizational:

Finance, Fleet and Building Maintenance and Intergovernmental Affairs will work through the grant application with Town of Morinville Administration.

The proposed agreement will ensure that replacement cost and on-going cost associated with the jointly owned infrastructure are shared in a fair and equitable manner.

Financial:

The cost of the project is estimated to be \$50,000.

An application is being submitted to the ACP program to fund the cost of the project.

Alternatives Considered

- 1. Independent framework by each municipality on maintenance and operations of the jointly owned facilities.
- 2. Deal with maintenance and operational issues as and when it arises.

Implications of Alternatives

Strategic Alignment:

 These options do not align with – Strong Local Governance and Regional Leadership

Organizational:

- The above options will likely result in duplication of efforts and tasks from both municipalities.
- It will increase the work load on Sturgeon County staff if meetings are required frequently to resolve issues as and when they arise.

Financial:

 These options will be less cost effective in comparison to the cooperative approach.

- Sturgeon County likely won't qualify for the grant as the grant is geared towards inter-municipal projects.

 Follow up Action

 1. Finance will complete the grant application process by submitting the Council motion to Municipal Affairs before February 3, 2017.
