STURGEON COUNTY, MORINVILLE, ALBERTA

BYLAW 1063/05 BEING A BYLAW OF STURGEON COUNTY, ALLOWING FOR A VOTE BY SPECIAL BALLOT.

WHEREAS, Sturgeon County Council received numerous requests in past Municipal Elections to allow for individuals to place their vote by Special Ballot;

WHEREAS, Sturgeon County Council wishes to encourage as many residents to vote as possible;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Council of Sturgeon County in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That, electors who are unable to vote at an advance vote or at the voting station on election day, for reasons outlined in Section 77.1 of the Local Authorities Election Act, may apply for a special ballot.

AND FURTHER, that this Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon the date of third reading and signing in accordance with Section 213 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000 C.M-26, and amendments thereto.

READ a first time this 28th day of June 2005.


READ a second time this 28th day of June 2005.
