Request for Decision

Title	Appoint Auditors 2018 to 2021				
Proposed Motion	That Council appoint the firm of Metrix Group LLP Chartered Professional Accountants as the external auditors for Sturgeon County for the years ending December 31, 2018 through December 31, 2021.				
Administrative Recommendation	Administration recommends that Council adhere to the Audit Policy, ensuring transparency in Sturgeon County's financial reporting.				
Previous Council Direction	June 27, 2017 – Motion 305/17 That Council appoint the firm of Hawkings Epp Dumont LLP Chartered Accountants as the external auditors for Sturgeon County for the year ended December 31, 2017. June 27, 2017 – Motion 304/17 That Council approve the Audit Policy.				
Report	Background Information				
	 On June 27, 2017, an Audit Policy was adopted by Council to appoint an External Auditor for a four-year term by July 1st on the second year following each general election. 				
	 On May 3, 2018, a Request for Proposal (RFP) was registered on the Alberta Purchasing Connection (APC) site and on Sturgeon County's website under "Current Business Opportunities" for proponents to submit proposals. 				
	• On May 28, 2018, five proposals were received, at which time Financial Services established a proposal evaluation team of four members, each experienced in working with audits and various audit firms.				
	 One proponent was disqualified at first reading for not meeting the mandatory submission requirements, which left the evaluation team with four proposals to score, received from Metrix Group LLP, Meyers Norris Penny LLP, Collins Barrow LLP and KPMG LLP. 				
	The evaluation team conducted a scoring process as per the terms laid out in the RFP. Each team member provided an independent score ranking, which was averaged to achieve the final score in each category.				

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- Proponents were scored in seven categories, being "Fees/Cost", "Project Plan", "Relevant Municipal Government Experience", "Relevant Experience, Qualifications Audit Team", "File Setup as well as changeover", "Proposal Quality" and "Firm Profile & Service Approach".
- Each of these criteria were provided a rating for a total of 100 points. Metrix Group LLP came in the highest at 90.25 points. Key success factors in their proposal were price, relevant experience and qualifications.
- The evaluation team performed reference checks on the top two proponents, Metrix Group LLP and Meyers Norris Penny LLP. References were favourable for both, resulting in Administration's recommendation to appoint Metrix Group LLP.
- If approved, Administration will bring an annual appointment of Auditors for Metrix Group over the next four years. A Request for Proposal for Audit Services will take place at the end of the four-year term.
- Annually, auditors must provide written confirmation of their independence to Management and Council. Proponents identified their roles and responsibilities to auditing standards in evaluating independence and potential conflicts of interest within their proposals.

Implication of Administrative Recommendation

Strategic Alignment:

Strong Local Governance and Regional Leadership: The selection of Metrix Group LLP will align with the Audit Policy established by Administration and approved by Council in June of 2017.

Organizational:

All RFP responses were from experienced, well-established firms. The criteria established and evaluated on allowed us to directly identify areas of strengths and weaknesses of respondents to come to a recommendation aside from cost alone.

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Alternatives Considered

That Council direct administration to select an alternate proponent for the external financial audit services.

Implications of **Alternatives**

Strategic Alignment:

Strong Local Governance and Regional Leadership: The selection of a financial audit service firm will align with the Audit Policy established by Administration and approved by Council in June of 2017.

Organizational:

May result in additional administrative time to orientate a new audit firm.

Financial:

Selecting another financial audit service firm would result in the aggregated total of the four-year term to be greater than \$146,300.

Follow up Action

1. Administration will communicate results with the successful proponent and execute a contract for the four-year term per the Audit Policy.
