# Request for Decision

Request for Cancellation of Property Tax Arrears – Roll #3704002
That Council refuse the request to cancel the 2019 property tax arrears for Roll #3704002.
Administration recommends that Council refuse the request to cancel the 2019 property tax arrears for Roll #3704002.
September 10, 2019 Tayla McHugh presented a request for the cancellation of her property tax arrears which are resulting from a penalty imposed after not paying 2019 property taxes on time.  April 23, 2019 – Motion 1434/19: That Council give third reading to Bylaw 1434/19 - 2019 Taxation Rates.  October 23, 2018 – Motion 302/18: That Council give third reading to Bylaw 1422/18 - Penalties on Unpaid Municipal Taxes.
<ul> <li>In accordance with Bylaw 1422/18, the Tax Penalty Bylaw, Sturgeon County municipal taxes are due on the last business day of June of each year.</li> <li>Payments for 2019 were required to be postmarked on or before June 28 or received at Sturgeon County Centre before the end of business (4:30 p.m.) on June 28 to avoid penalty charges.</li> <li>County residents were made aware of this date, as it was provided on their tax notices. Notice was also posted on Sturgeon's County website.</li> <li>Tax penalties are in place to ensure the timely payment of property taxes. Late penalty charges for the 2019 tax year are as follows:         <ul> <li>6% of current levy - June 29, 2019;</li> <li>6% of current levy - August 1, 2019;</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

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- The County offers a Tax Installment Payment Plan (TIPP) that allows property owners in Sturgeon County to pay their property tax in monthly installments throughout the year rather than a single payment. The intent is to break residents' property taxes into more manageable amounts, making it easier to budget and ensure taxes are paid on time.
- On July 15, 2019, Administration received a request from a taxpayer to make a presentation to Council requesting the cancellation of the tax penalty of \$294.73 applied to roll #3704002.
- The balance on the taxpayer's account reflects the outstanding penalty amount of \$294.73, as payment was received for taxes on July 12, 2019.
- The taxpayer took title in 2017. The taxpayer paid 2017 and 2018 taxes on or before the due date without penalty.
- On September 10, 2019, the taxpayer presented her request to Council to cancel penalties levied for 2019. Her presentation materials are included as Attachment 1.
- In accordance with section 347(1) of the Municipal Government Act
  (MGA), if Council considers it equitable to do so, it may cancel or reduce
  tax arrears. However, Administration recommends that Council refuse
  this request as it does not align with Council Policy ADM-Tax-2 and may
  set a precedent.

# Relevant Policy/Legislation/Practices:

- Section 344 of the Municipal Government Act (MGA) provides for Council to impose a penalty for non-payment of taxes in the current year.
- Section 347(1) of the MGA states that Council may, if it considers it equitable to do so, cancel or reduce tax arrears.
- Bylaw 1422/18 Penalties on Unpaid Municipal Taxes Bylaw.
- Policy ADM-Tax-2: Tax penalties will not for any reason be cancelled unless a proven human or machine error is made by Sturgeon County staff.

# **Implication of** Administrative Recommendation

### Strategic Alignment:

# **Strong Local Governance & Regional**

The imposition of a penalty on owed taxes is consistent with legislation, policies and procedures and supports Goal 3.2 - Sturgeon County is financially stable and fiscally responsible.

## Organizational:

No additional work is required other than issuing a letter informing the taxpayer of Council's decision.

## Financial:

The penalty issued on June 29, 2019 (\$294.73) represents 6% of the total taxes levied on Roll #3704002 for the 2019 taxation year.

# **Alternatives** Considered

Council could decide to waive tax arrears in the amount of \$294.73.

# **Implications of Alternatives**

### **Strategic Alignment:**

A decision to waive tax arrears would not be consistent with Goal 3.2 – Sturgeon County is financially stable and fiscally responsible.

#### Organizational:

Administration would remove the penalty from the tax account.

# Financial:

Does not materially impact budget but may set a precedent.

Follow up Action 1. Administration will send a letter to the taxpayer informing them of Council's decision (Financial Services, September 2019).
