Report	Background Information			
	 Charities and other voluntary and community organizations play a vital role in our lives and the volunteers deserve public recognition and support. 			
	Sturgeon County benefits from having a wide range of volunteers who are involved in Council Boards and Committees, Community Associations, Fire Departments, Schools and School Boards, Hospital Boards, Senior Housing, 4-H, food banks, libraries, etc.			
	• In 2017, volunteering comes in many forms and helps to build a stronger Sturgeon County.			
	Volunteers make positive contributions to the happiness and quality of life of others - it's a great way to meet people, to get the most out of your local area and to increase your own happiness and well-being.			
	• It is our desire to provide some special recognition to the local community groups who are active contributors to recreation and cultural events in our neighbourhoods. The desired intent is to encourage active collaboration with not-for-profit volunteer organizations to facilitate recreation and cultural programming that is reflective of the needs of the residents.
