Land Management Services - Efficiency and Policy Review

- Department: Development Support Services
- Cost: \$70,000 one time
- Brief Description:
 - County currently spends hundreds of hours and incurs direct costs for land management items (land acquisition and disposition, easements, negotiations, agreements, road closures, MR, ER, PUL properties, leasing, encroachments, occupations, County policy and process, and public education interface).
 - Several legacy issues require attention, such as inconsistent application of encroachments and license of occupations, infrastructure installed without easements or RoWs, enforcement protocols, etc.
 - Review required to consider potential efficiencies from consolidation of the efforts, recommendations on a way forward on legacy issues, and new policy / program foundations.
 - Would be completed in fall 2020, for Council consideration in budget 2021

2020 One-Time Operating Service Enhancement (Awaiting Council Direction and Funding)

Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) and Commercial Development Analysis Implementation

- Department: Economic Development Services
- Cost: \$25,000 per year, initially
- Brief Description:
 - Supports implementation of action plan modules for Foreign Direct
 Investment (FDI) Strategy and Commercial Development Analysis (CDA)
 - Activities include increased lead and site selection, targeted engagement, investment prospects and listings, marketing/advertising, broker engagement, event hosting and attendance
