From supporting family members and friends to assisting charities and volunteering, seniors are deeply involved in our communities and their contributions benefit Albertans of all ages.</li> <li>Each year, Albertans are encouraged to join the festivities by attending one of the many Seniors' Week events to be held across the province. Whether planning an event or enjoying one with the seniors in your life, please take the time to acknowledge Alberta's seniors and all that they contribute to our quality of life. Participation in Seniors' Week helps highlight and show appreciation for Alberta's seniors.</li> <li>Alberta Seniors &amp; Housing encourages municipalities to show their support for seniors in their areas by officially proclaiming Seniors' Week each year.</li> <li>There are eight (8) recognized senior clubs represented on the Sturgeon County Advisory Council and who are very active in the community.</li> <li>Canada's seniors' population (those over the age of 65) increased by 20% year over year (2011 to 2016); 12% of Sturgeon County's population is over 65 years old, increasing from 1,920 in 2011 to 2,470 in 2016.</li> <li>Several seniors were recently recognized at the Volunteer Appreciation event held April 26.
