

**BYLAW 1396/17
AMENDMENT TO THE PROCEEDINGS OF
COUNCIL AND ITS COMMITTEES BYLAW 1301/13
STURGEON COUNTY, MORINVILLE, ALBERTA**

BYLAW 1396/17 BEING A BYLAW OF STURGEON COUNTY, MORINVILLE, ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING THE PROCEEDINGS OF COUNCIL AND ITS COMMITTEES BYLAW 1301/13

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000 C.M-26, any amendments or successor legislation thereto authorize Council to establish and amend the Proceedings of Council and Its Committees Bylaw 1301/13;

NOW THEREFORE that the Council of Sturgeon County, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That the Proceedings of Council and its Committees Bylaw 1301/13 is hereby amended as follows:
 - a. Delete the following:

MEMBER DEBATING:

28. Members wishing to speak on a matter should indicate their intention by raising their hand and being recognized by the Chair and should not speak more than once until every Member has had the opportunity to speak except:

- b. Add the following:

MEMBER DEBATING:

28. Members wishing to speak on a matter should indicate their intention by the raising of hands, or, by the use of an electronic voting technology or, verbally in the case of an electronic meeting, once recognized by the Chair. The Member should not speak more than once until every Member has had the opportunity to speak except:

- c. Delete the following:

41. Votes shall be made by the raising of hands as the Chair calls for those in favor or against.

d. Add the following:

ELECTRONIC VOTING

41. Electronic voting technology displaying the result of the vote on motions shall be used during Council meetings. When the electronic voting technology is in operation:

1.1. All members shall vote using the electronic voting technology, unless excused from voting; and

1.2. All vote results shall be recorded and publicly displayed.

41.1. When electronic voting technology is unavailable, Council shall vote on motions by raising their hands upon the call of the Chair for all those in favor or opposed.

41.2. The Chair shall announce the result of all the votes at a meeting by stating whether the motion was carried or defeated.

2. That this Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon the date of third reading.
