
BYLAW 1119/07**PENALTIES ON UNPAID MUNICIPAL TAXES
AMENDMENT TO BYLAW 805/95
STURGEON COUNTY, MORINVILLE, ALBERTA**

BYLAW 1119/07, BEING A BYLAW OF STURGEON COUNTY, FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING BYLAW 805/95 TO SPECIFY A TIME FOR THE PAYMENT OF CURRENT TAXES AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE IMPOSITION OF PENALTIES FOR NONPAYMENT OF CURRENT TAXES AND TAX ARREARS.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26.1 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, and amendments thereto, authorizes a Council, by Bylaw, to impose penalties in the year in which a tax is imposed if the tax remains unpaid after the date shown on the tax notice;

WHEREAS, the penalty must not be imposed sooner than 30 days after the tax notice is sent out;

AND WHEREAS, the Council of Sturgeon has deemed it desirable to amend Bylaw 805/95 to specify a time for the payment of current taxes and to provide for the imposition of penalties for non-payment of current taxes and tax arrears;

NOW THEREFORE, Pursuant to Provisions of the Municipal Government Act, RSA Chapter M-26.1, the Council of Sturgeon County, in the Province of Alberta enacts as follows:

1. a) Section 2 of Bylaw 805/95 is hereby amended by deleting the words “30th day of June” and replacing them with the words “last business day of June”.
- b) Section 3 of Bylaw 805/95 is hereby amended by deleting the words “30th day of June” and replacing them with the words “last business day of June”.
2. This Bylaw 1119/07 shall come into force and take effect upon the third and final reading.

READ a second time this 8th day of May 2007.
