Report	Background Information		
	 Administration's recommended changes to the schedule are displayed in Attachment #1: 2017 Fees and Charges Schedule. Explanatory notes have been added to each item. 		
	With the approval of proposed Land Use Bylaw 1385/17 there will be several new land uses (for example, secondary suites, apartment, duplex and mixed-use development) that require setting new application fees for development permits.		
	 Provision has also been made in the schedule for: Application fees in DC-districts; An Administrative fee for a Development Agreement for the payment of a deposit/security; A standard Application fee for single detached dwellings; Reduction of the Application fee for natural resource extraction; Reduction of the Application fee for variances; and A septic system upgrade deposit. 		
	The revised Fees and Charges Schedule provides for fees per zoning district (where possible) and listing those uses that are separate to those fees. The Schedule has been compiled as well to make it user-friendly (e.g. colour coded) to ensure consistent application of the fees.		
	 It should also be noted Current Planning & Development Services will be undertaking a review of its fees in 2017 and comparing against other comparable Alberta municipalities, and will bring forward recommendations as part of the 2018 budget process.

Administration may not be able to collect fees for a variety of land uses until the revisions to the Fees and Charges Schedule have been approved.

Administration will implement the new Fees and Charges Schedule and ensure that it is placed on the County's website and available to the public.
