Report	 Seniors make a difference in our communities every day, from supporting family members and friends to assisting charities and volunteering. Each year, Albertans are encouraged to join the festivities by attending one of the many Seniors' Week events to be held across the province. Whether planning an event or enjoying one with the seniors in your life, please take the time to acknowledge Alberta's seniors and all that they contribute to our quality of life. Your participation in Seniors' Week helps highlight and show appreciation for Alberta's seniors. Alberta Seniors and Housing encourages municipalities to show their support for seniors in their areas by officially proclaiming Seniors' Week each year. 		
	 Staff in Community Services have a specific role in meeting the needs of our aging population so that our seniors living in Sturgeon County have the information and support they require to remain in their homes: We provide support to the Sturgeon County Senior Citizens Advisory Council, which is represented by nine (9) recognized senior clubs that are very active in the community; We host the annual Seniors' Conference in September; We provide seniors' groups transportation through the year; Our Information & Referral service is utilized frequently by our seniors who are wanting income and home supports;

- Our Living Well Counselling Service is available to our seniors to support their well-being and resilience;
- We sponsor free library memberships for our seniors during the month of June to promote discovery and lifelong learning;
- We continue to be engaged with the University of Alberta's Medically At-Risk Driver (MARD) Centre in building an "Alternate Transportation for Seniors Service" for the Sturgeon Region;
- Sturgeon County provides annual operating funds to our seniors' groups operating facilities in the Sturgeon Region.
- 25% of our region's population is over the age of 55.

External Communication

- A Seniors' Week advertisement will be prepared for Sturgeon FYI.
- Proclamation information will be forwarded to the local libraries.

Relevant Policy/Legislation/Practices:

Sturgeon County's standard practice has been to proclaim Seniors' Week and offer free library memberships for Sturgeon County seniors (55+) throughout the month of June.

Implication of Administrative Recommendation

Community Identity & Spirit – Valuing our seniors and engaging in conversations around programs and services that support seniors in our rural community is important. Their contributions warrant appreciation and recognition, and their stories deserve to be told.
