Proposed Motion:

- 3. That Council direct Administration to focus feasibility and design for the Meadowview Drive Rehabilitation Project on the existing Meadowview Drive alignment, from Highway 44 to Range Road 261A, and without widening of the existing road right-of-way.
- 4. That Council direct Administration to obtain proposals for the detailed design and construction of Meadowview Drive Rehabilitation Project, and bring back a debenture bylaw for funding of these projects for design and construction.
