






Overview of the Proposed WastAway Project

WastAway Facility that will process 100,000 tonnes of MSW per year, including:

- 3 WastAway process lines
- Pelletizer equipment for all WastAway output
- Parts Inventory
- Rolling Equipment (ie front end loader, high lift etc)
- Installation and freight
- Building
- Scale house, site work
- Engineering and contingency





25 New Jobs in the WastAway Project

WastAway Facility will create 25 NEW full time jobs

- A unskilled labourer salary will be approximately \$54,000 plus benefits with salaries going up from there.
- We will need office staff, mechanics, labourers, boiler engineers and a plant manager





Triple Bottom Line:
