Title	Contract Award Recommendation: Range Road 233 (from Township Road 572 to Township Road 573)
Proposed Motion	That Council award the contract for the reconstruction of Range Road 233 from Township Road 572 to Township Road 573 to Noyen Construction Ltd., at a contract price of \$696,769.00 (not including GST).
Administrative Recommendation	Administration recommends that Council award the contact for the reconstruction of Range Road 233 from Twp Rd 572 to Twp Rd 573 to Noyen Construction Ltd, at a contract price of \$696,769.00 (not including GST) with an anticipated overall project budget estimated to be \$980,926.10.

Report	 Background Information Range Road 233 – From Township Road 572 to Township Road 573 Range Road 233 was tendered through the Alberta Purchasing Connection on January 10, 2017. Tenders closed on January 24, 2017 at 2:00 PM. We received twelve (12) bids ranging from \$696,769.00 to \$1,712,984.00 excluding GST. The engineering consultant, AMEC Foster Wheeler, reviewed the tenders and recommends Sturgeon County award the contract for Range Road 233 to Noyen Construction Ltd. The existing surface of Range Road 233 is gravel. The project will prepare Range Road 233 for paving in 2018. Project is a total of 1.74 km of reconstruction. Range Road 233 is considered a Collector Road in the Roadway Classification network for Sturgeon County. Maintenance costs average \$2,000 - \$3,000/km. Traffic count indicates 300 vehicles per day. Sight lines at intersection need improvement. Administration will provide an overall vision of how this project ties into the
