	<ul> <li>Council provided direction to Administration to move forward with an initiative to improve the quality of the roads network.</li> <li>Administration has engaged the public as follows: <ul> <li>through two community meetings: Villeneuve and Gibbons.</li> <li>a public survey was distributed with 1,813 responses received.</li> <li>ongoing customer calls and Council requests.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

• In 2016, a consultant was retained to create a Sustainable Roads Improvement Strategy (SRIS). The SRIS will be utilized to guide the maintenance and capital program improvements of County roads for the next 20 years.
