# Request for Decision

Title	Sturgeon County <i>Modernized Municipal Government Act</i> Regulations Submission (Round 1)
Proposed Motion	That Council approve the recommended <i>Modernized Municipal Government Act</i> Regulations submission, and authorize the Mayor to submit it to the Minister of Municipal Affairs on behalf of Sturgeon County Council.
Administrative Recommendation	That Council approve the submission package as presented, and authorize the Mayor to send it to the Minister of Municipal Affairs on behalf of Council.

Report	Background Information
	Over the last three (3) years, the Government of Alberta has undertaken

- Over the last three (3) years, the Government of Alberta has undertaken a complete review of the Municipal Government Act, Alberta's enabling legislation for municipalities.
- Sturgeon County Council has been actively engaged throughout the review process and has submitted formal and informal feedback on Bill 20 in 2015 and Bill 21 in 2016.

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- On December 6, 2016, the Government passed Bill 21, the Modernized Municipal Government Act. However, there are a number of existing Regulations that require updating and new Regulations that need to be established in order to fully implement the changes of both Bill 20 and Bill 21.
- On January 31, 2017, the first set of draft Regulations were released for public comment, and the Government requested any and all feedback to be provided by March 31, 2017.
- The intention is to have the *Modernized Municipal Government Act* and all associated Regulations in place by the fall of 2017.
- Of the Regulations released to-date, Sturgeon County Administration
  has no major concerns and is recommending that Council either support
  or provide 'no comment' on each Regulation.
- This review is consistent with the briefing information provided by the AAMDC on February 10, 2017.
