Proposed Motion	That Council approve the Off-site Levy Policy as presented, to establish clear principles and procedures pertaining to the implementation of Off-site Levy Bylaws in Sturgeon County.
Administrative Recommendation	That Administration recommends approval of the implementation of the Off-site Levy Policy as the process promotes transparency and streamlines processes.

Report	 Background Information The Off-site Levy Policy framework was presented to Committee of the Whole on March 14, 2017, and March 22, 2016. Inputs brought forward at these meetings have been were included in the final report and recommended Policy. With this policy, Council will guide: the timing of when off-site levies are assessed; when off-site levies are payable; when and how front-ended infrastructure construction costs are assigned and credited to developers; and when and how front-ended construction costs are reimbursed to developers. The policy will guide Administration's work and recommendations to Council relating to development within the County.

	• Once adopted, the policy and attached framework ("Schedule A") wil be provided to developers at time of application. The framework provides clear guidance on when development is subject to an off-site levy and when it is exempt.
