Request for Decision

Title	Appointment of Agricultural Fieldmen
Proposed Motion	That Council appoint Alyssa Hutchings and Victoria Dubord as Agricultural Fieldmen under the Alberta <i>Agricultural Service Board Act.</i>
Administrative Recommendation	Administration recommends the appointment of the individuals.
Previous Council Direction	None.
Report	 Agricultural Fieldmen aid in the implementation of agricultural policies and programs as well as manage agricultural resources of a municipality. Agricultural Fieldmen are designated municipal inspectors under the Alberta Weed Control Act, Agricultural Pests Act and the Alberta Soil Conservation Act. Under the Agricultural Service Board Act, if a board is established, municipalities are responsible for ensuring that an Agricultural Fieldman is appointed to implement agricultural policies and programs. Sturgeon County receives Agricultural Service Board Grant funds from the province to contribute to eligible Agricultural Service Board Programs if municipalities adhere to all requirements under the Agricultural Service Board Act. Failure to appoint an Agricultural Fieldman may result in failure to uphold the functions, duties and powers of the municipality under the Alberta Weed Control Act, Agricultural Pests Act, the Alberta Soil Conservation Act and the Alberta Agricultural Service Board Act. Relevant Policy/Legislation/Practices: Under Section 8(1) of the Agricultural Service Board Act, if a council establishes a board, the council shall appoint a qualified person(s) as Agricultural Fieldman to implement agricultural policies and programs, manage agricultural resources of the municipality, and act as a designated

officer under all Acts related to agriculture.

Implication of Administrative Recommendation

Strategic Alignment:

This recommendation is consistent with multiple goals under each Focus area of the Sturgeon County Strategic Plan.

Organizational:

Vegetation Management, Pest Control and Environmental Conservation are programs facilitated for county residents. Proactive and reactive Weed and Pest Control are key services within these programs.

The appointment of Agricultural Fieldmen cross trained in the administration of the *Weed Control Act, Agricultural Pests Act* and *Soil Conservation Act* allows the municipality to deliver services efficiently. They support the goals of the Agricultural Services Board and implement agricultural policies and programs to best serve Sturgeon County residents.

<u>Financial:</u>

No impact.

Alternatives Considered

1. That Council refrain from appointing an Agricultural Fieldman required to administer the *Weed Control Act, Agricultural Pests Act, Soil Conservation Act* and *Agricultural Service Board Act*.

Implications of Alternatives

Strategic Alignment:

This recommendation is not consistent with the Sturgeon County Strategic Plan Focus Areas, specifically Strong Local Governance and Regional Leadership

Organizational:

If a municipality fails to appoint an Agricultural Fieldman, they would fail to uphold the legislative functions, duties and powers of the municipality under the Alberta *Weed Control Act*, Alberta *Agricultural Pests Act*, Alberta *Soil Conservation Act*, and the Alberta *Agricultural Service Board Act*.

Financial:

Should no Agricultural Fieldman be appointed, a loss in provincial grant funding would ensue due to noncompliance with the *Agricultural Service Board Act*. The municipality may also incur penalties for not upholding its legislative responsibilities under the *Agricultural Service Board Act*, *Weed Control Act*, *Agricultural Pests Act* and *Soil Conservation Act*.

Follow up Action

1. Issuance of Agricultural Fieldman Identification, as per the *Weed Control Act, Agricultural Pests Act,* and *Soil Conservation Act* (Agriculture Services, May 2017).
