Previous Council Direction	April 28, 2015 (Committee of the Whole): Presentation on Enhanced Road Maintenance Update.
Report	<p><u>Background Information</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Presentation lays out rationale for conducting the Shoulder Pull program as a means to: improve drainage, re-establish crown, driveability and road stability, reduce maintenance costs, and increase road life span.• 2016 successes and learnings which pivot around resident expectations and feedback is utilized in establishing new criteria for selecting road maintenance candidates (which includes shoulder pull candidates).• Collaboration with Engineering in identifying road maintenance techniques based on unique road conditions and Engineering's involvement in road maintenance and reconstruction selection criteria is a contributing success factor.• Future outlook for road maintenance is to have all roads classified to a program: Gravel Road Improvement Program, Road Repair Program (Shoulder Pull, Maintenance), Road Reconstruction Program (SRIS Option, Capital). <p><u>External Communication</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• County Connections• Ongoing media requests
