Report	<ul> <li>Background Information</li> <li>Administration's recommended changes to the schedule are displayed in Attachment #1: 2017 Fees and Charges Schedule. Explanatory notes have been added to each item.</li> <li>With the approval of proposed Land Use Bylaw 1385/17, there will be several new land uses (for example, secondary suites, apartment, duplex and mixed use development) that require setting new application fees for development permits.</li> </ul>				
	<ul> <li>Provision has also been made in the schedule for:</li> <li>Application fees in DC-districts;</li> <li>An Administrative fee for a Development Agreement for the payment of a deposit/security;</li> <li>A standard Application fee for single detached dwellings;</li> <li>Reduction of the Application fee for natural resource extraction;</li> <li>Reduction of the Application fee for variances; and</li> <li>A septic system upgrade deposit.</li> </ul>				
	• The revised Fees and Charges Schedule provides for basic fees per zoning district (where possible) and listing those uses that are separate to those basic fees. The Schedule has been compiled as well to make it user-friendly (e.g. colour coded) to ensure consistent application for the fees.
