# **Request for Decision**

# Title FCM Grant Application **Proposed Motion** 1. That Council direct Administration to apply for a grant opportunity from the Federation of Canadian Municipalities' - Asset Management Program for Road Asset Condition Assessment and Recommendations. 2. That Council direct Administration to engage the services of a third party to complete a condition assessment and a road condition analysis on a subclass of road assets funded by the Transportation Operating Budget. Administrative Administration recommends that County Council authorize Administration Recommendation to apply for the Asset Management grant through the Federation of Canadian Municipalities (FCM). **Previous Council** None. Direction

# **Report** Background Information

- During the CNAM (Canadian Network of Asset Managers) Conference, it
  was brought forward that there was a grant opportunity that FCM
  would be administering, to help municipalities progress with their Asset
  Management Program.
- As part of the grant application, a readiness scale was required as a means for organizations to understand where they are in their asset management journey, and also a standardized approach for FCM to understand where applicants are.
- In reviewing the readiness scale and grant application, it is important to understand that municipalities should strive towards being in the third or fourth scale of the readiness scale to say they have a successful asset management program.
- The intent of the grant is to move the municipality up one grade, in one competency.
- Administration completed SRIS (Sustainable Roads Improvements Strategy) in 2017. Having a third party conduct a road condition analysis on sub-class of roads would allow for Administration to prioritize maintenance treatments in conjunction with capital priorities.

#### Organizational:

Continuing to develop Sturgeon County's asset management journey will help ensure that we have adequately planned our infrastructure for the future. The means setting levels of service standards for our assets, maintenance strategies to ensure a sustainable useful life of our assets and replacement of said assets.

## Financial:

The FCM Asset Management Grant requires that municipalities fund the lesser of \$50,000 and 80% of eligible project costs. There are **NO** funding extensions allowed, and all project expenditures must be incurred within an 11-month time period. Sturgeon County will fund our portion from within our current operating budget.
