	On August 24, 2012, the County entered an agreement with North West Redwater Partnership (NWR) for the property taxes prepayment of \$5,588,000 taxes in respect of Sturgeon Refinery. The prepayment was received by the County on December 21, 2012.				
	The agreement provides for 5 equal annual credits of \$1,117,600 towards taxes on the Sturgeon Refinery from June 30, 2017 to June 30, 2021.				
	This agreement was amended on November 8, 2016, to align the tax credit to years the County was most likely to receive taxes from the refinery.
