Request for Decision

Title	Award of Contract for the Supply and Delivery of Gasoline, Dyed Diesel and Clear Diesel
Proposed Motion	That Council authorize Administration to sign a one-year agreement for the supply and delivery of gasoline, dyed diesel and clear diesel from North Central Co-operative Association Ltd.
Administrative Recommendation	That Sturgeon County maintain an open and transparent approach to fuel procurement.
Previous Council Direction	<u>December 20, 2017</u> Motion 506/17: That Council approve the 2018 Operating and Capital budget, as amended.
Report	 Background Information The invitation to tender was prepared based on current usage, delivery locations and types of fuels required.

- The tenders for the supply and delivery of gasoline, dyed diesel and clear diesel were opened on Wednesday, February 7, 2018, in public in accordance with the tender instructions. Administration has reviewed and analyzed each bid.
- Fuel prices fluctuate daily. Comparing delivery charges, management fees, applicable discounts along with the provided daily rack price has provided some clarity for this recommendation.

External Communication

The Request for Tenders for the Supply and Delivery of Regular (87 octane) Gasoline, Dyed Diesel, and Clear Diesel was posted on the Alberta Purchasing Connections website. The New West Partnership Trade Agreement (NWPTA) and the Agreement on Internal Trade (AIT) apply to this purchase.

Relevant Policy/Legislation/Practices:

 Procurement Directive dir_pro_fin_2014 indicates that tenders exceeding \$500,000 should be ratified at the following Council Meeting.

Implication of Administrative Recommendation

Strategic Alignment:

This recommendation is consistent with the Sturgeon County Strategic Plan's Focus Areas of Strong Local Governance and Regional Leadership, Respect for the Environment, and Operational Excellence.

Organizational:

Sturgeon County recognizes the need to maintain an open transparent approach to fuel procurement.

Financial:

The approved fuel budget is \$1,028,268. Based on projections from the recommendation, Sturgeon County can expect a cost of approximately \$900,000 for the 2018 fiscal year. This cost includes all three fuels.

Alternatives Considered

Recommendation:

- That Council refer tender discussion to Committee of the Whole for reconsideration of tender selection weighting of evaluation criteria.
- That a three-year agreement be considered to better manage service fees by freezing fees for those three (3) years.

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Implications of Alternatives

Strategic Alignment:

This recommendation is consistent with the Sturgeon County Strategic Plan's Focus Areas of Strong Local Governance and Regional Leadership, Respect for the Environment, and Planned Growth and emerging focus area of Operational Effectiveness.

Organizational:

It is recommended to award the contract for the supply and delivery of gasoline, dyed diesel and clear diesel to ensure consistent uninterrupted service to our machinery.

Financial:

Alternatives would result in additional fees and charges from all other vendors and potential interruptions due to distance aside from UFA.

Follow up Action

Fleet Services will enter into agreement with the vendor for the supply and delivery of gasoline, dyed diesel and clear diesel for a term of one year, to be signed in accordance with the Sturgeon County procurement directive.
