Request for Decision

Title	Award of Contract for the Purchase of Two (2) Motor Graders		
Proposed Motion	That Council authorize Administration to purchase two (2) 872GP Motor Graders from Brandt Tractor for the aggregate price of \$896,000 (not including GST).		
Administrative Recommendation	That Sturgeon County adheres to the established equipment replacement plan and process for equipment selection.		
Previous Council Direction	December 20, 2017 Motion 506/17: That Council approve the 2018 Operating and Capital budget, as amended.		

Report Background Information

- The tenders were prepared based on consultations with end users,
 Supervisors and relevant Managers.
- The tenders for the motor graders were opened on Tuesday January 30, 2018, in public in accordance with the tender instructions.
 Administration has reviewed and analyzed each bid.
- Fleet Maintenance has analyzed the tenders and made the recommendation based on the following criteria:

Finning Canada and Brandt Tractor were the only two bidders on the medium-sized motor graders.

The Request for Tenders for the motor graders was posted on the Alberta Purchasing Connections website. The New West Partnership Trade Agreement (NWPTA) and the Agreement on Internal Trade (AIT) apply to this purchase.

Implication of Administrative Recommendation

Strategic Alignment:

This recommendation is consistent with Sturgeon County Strategic Plan's Focus Areas of Strong Local Governance and Regional Leadership, Respect for the Environment, and Operational Excellence.

Organizational:

Consistent capital reinvestment in our heavy equipment is a key component of consistently delivering a defined level of service. Our ability to effectively execute is directly related to the quality of tools provided to Sturgeon County staff. Regular rotation enables greater machine uptime while maximizing the resale value of the equipment being replaced and minimizing repair costs.

Financial:

The approved budget for the two (2) Motor Graders was \$940,000 less the estimated sale of assets of \$300,000 with a net cost from current tax dollars of \$640,000.

Sale proceeds projections are conservative. The County typically meets or exceeds sale proceeds budgets by monitoring the market and choosing optimum time to sell.

If sale proceeds are greater than expected, the proceeds will be transferred back to the Equipment Reserve.

Alternatives Considered

Recommendation:

That Council refer tender discussion to Committee of the Whole for reconsideration of tender selection weighting of evaluation criteria.

Implications of Alternatives

Strategic Alignment:

This recommendation is consistent with the Sturgeon County Strategic Plan's Focus Areas of Strong Local Governance and Regional Leadership, Respect for the Environment, and Planned Growth and emerging focus area of Operational Effectiveness.

Organizational:

It is recommended to award the contract for the two (2) motor graders to allow the machines to be ordered and supplied as soon as possible, thus keeping the County in line with the established Replacement Plan.

Financial:

Alternatives to lower initial purchase expense will introduce higher operating costs and a lower salvage value.

Follow up Action

Fleet Maintenance will initiate a purchase contract with the vendor for the supply of the Motor Graders to be signed in accordance with Sturgeon County Procurement Directive.
