Previous Council Direction	September 27, 2016 - Council received a presentation on the Growth Plan which referenced the submission of a Regional Context Statement to define how Sturgeon County's Municipal Development Plan conforms or diverges from the new Growth Plan and how it will be brought into conformance if not aligned.	
Report	Background Information	
	The Edmonton Metropolitan Region Board (EMRB) Growth Plan was revised and submitted to the Province of Alberta for approval in October 2017. One of the Growth Plan requirements is for the EMRB's 13-member municipalities to submit Regional Context Statements.	
	The Regional Context Statements are intended to:	
	 Identify where each member municipality's Municipal Development Plan conforms or diverges from the Growth Plan's 	

The Growth Plan requires municipalities to conform to the following Policy Areas:

Development Plan into conformance, if required.

2. Clarify how each member municipality will bring their Municipal

- 1. Economic Competitiveness and Employment
- 2. Natural Living Systems

objectives; and

- 3. Communities and Housing
- 4. Integration of Land Use and Infrastructure
- 5. Transportation Systems
- 6. Agriculture

Municipal Development Plans (MDPs) must support the objectives found under these Policy Areas, failure to conform to these policies would require the amendment of that Municipal Development Plan.

Sturgeon County's Alignment

Sturgeon County is in general conformance with the new EMRB Growth Plan. Attachment 1 identifies this conformance as well as recommended amendments to provide better clarity or alignment.

Areas where Sturgeon County's MDP requires an amendment to better conform to the Growth Plan will be addressed by Administration during a scheduled update in 2020.

External Factors

Currently, Sturgeon County is working through a variety of local and regional processes which may influence or otherwise inform the amendments required for the Sturgeon County MDP. Sturgeon County is currently subject to the following primary and secondary considerations:

Primary considerations include:

- 1. St. Albert Annexation
- 2. Sturgeon Valley Special Study Area

Secondary considerations include:

- 1. Regional Agricultural Master Plan
- 2. Integrated Transportation Master Plan
- 3. Metropolitan Region Servicing Plan
- 4. Infrastructure Master Plan
- 5. Local Agricultural Support Strategy
- 6. Intermunicipal Development Plans
- 7. Intermunicipal Collaboration Frameworks

Primary considerations will provide the greatest influence on future recommended amendments to the Sturgeon County MDP. To provide proper conformance with the EMRB Growth Plan, these processes should be completed or be near completion. If these factors are not resolved before the MDP amendment deadline, a submission extension may be requested at Council's discretion.

External Communication

Administration has reviewed Regional Context Statement requirements with EMRB Administration and have consulted other regional municipalities regarding their approaches.

Strategic Alignment:

Strong Local Governance and Regional Leadership – The directions for consideration outlined within the report outline the County's intent to be collaborative with the EMRB and conform with its Regional Policies.
