Request for Decision

Title	2018 Property Tax Write-off		
Proposed Motion	That Council authorize the write-off of taxes owing in the amount of \$39,719.87, as per the presented tax roll list, as these accounts are no longer collectible.		
Administrative Recommendation	That Council, as led by the <i>Municipal Government Act</i> , R.S.A 2000 c. M-26 Section 347(1), ensures Sturgeon County Financial Statements reflect the actual amount of property taxes expected to be collected.		
Previous Council Direction	None.		
Report	 The write-off of tax arrears in the amount of \$39,719.87 is related to: Six (6) Linear accounts; Eight (8) Oilfield accounts; Five (5) Grant-in-Lieu of Taxes (Provincial Government); Two (2) Farmland lease accounts. Sturgeon County adjusts taxes receivable to allow for uncollectible accounts each year as part of the audit process to ensure receivables and revenues are not overstated. Six oilfield companies, which are unlikely to be collected, affect five linear and five oilfield tax rolls. Administration has attempted collection with a civil collection agency and the companies have gone bankrupt in prior years, therefore, collection is not likely. 		
	 One oilfield company is unlikely to be collected, which affects one linear and three oilfield tax rolls, as the company is in bankruptcy. The fees to pursue collections are in excess of the taxes outstanding. Two farmland lease accounts were terminated in prior years. This property is now part of a highway; therefore, title change for collection is not possible. Accounts are currently inactive. 		
	 The five Grant-in-Lieu of Taxes accounts are writing off the 2017 education and homeland housing requisitions as Municipal Affairs no longer provides a grant for these requisitions. Sturgeon County wrote off taxes owing in the amount of \$72,537.12 in 2017. 		

Date Written: November 29, 2018 Council Meeting Date: December 11, 2018 Oilfield and linear accounts also have until June 30th to settle taxes owed. If they remain unpaid, Sturgeon County engages the services of a bailiff. The bailiff makes considerable attempts to seize property owned by the company responsible for the tax accounts to recoup the taxes owed. If the said company is in receivership due to bankruptcy, Sturgeon County is listed as a creditor with the receiver to be eligible for payments from the proceeds of the sale of the company's assets. In some cases, the proceeds of the salvageable assets are not sufficient to pay the fees associated with receivership, which are first in line before other creditors.
