Report	<ul> <li>Background Information</li> <li>Rivière Qui Barre Rockers Senior Society contacted Sturgeon County through Community Services to do a startup for their group and to obtain insurance as an additional named on the County's insurance policy.</li> </ul>				
	<ul> <li>policy.</li> <li>The Additional Named Insured Program is offered by the Rural Municipalities of Alberta (RMA) Insurance, which allows municipalities to support their communities by providing a cost-effective, efficient and comprehensive insurance alternative for non-profit groups that qualify.</li> </ul>				
	• RMA Insurance reviews Additional Named Insurance requests for eligibility prior to Council decision and has determined that the Rivière Qui Barre Rockers Senior Society is eligible. Administration has been working with RMA Insurance to facilitate this request.				
	<ul> <li>The Rivière Qui Barre Rockers Senior Society holds monthly meetings and promotes quality of life fellowship and recreational activities amon its members.</li> </ul>				
	<ul> <li>Sturgeon County Council has previously approved 16 Additional Named Insured associations under its insurance policy to date. Each Additional Named Insured is required to enter into an agreement with Sturgeon County as the master policy holder. All Additional Named Insured are responsible to pay their own insurance premiums.</li> </ul>				
	• RMA does not require Sturgeon County to have representation on the boards of each Additional Named Insured, as it would be acceptable to be provided with minutes of all board meetings as well as keep the				

	County involved and informed of any and all actions related to a claim i one should arise.

	• Each Additional Named Insured association requires a resolution from Council approving their addition to Sturgeon County's insurance policy outlining that Council is aware of the risks and responsibilities of adding the Additional Named Insured.
