Title	Appointment of Agricultural Inspectors			
Proposed Motion	That Council appoint Cathryn Thompson, Tanysha Van Hecke, Justin Ste and Hannah Smith as municipal inspectors under the <i>Agricultural Pests</i> and the <i>Weed Control Act</i> .			
Administrative Recommendation	That Council approve the proposed motion.			
Previous Council Direction	April 24, 2018 – Motion 120/18: That Council appoint Cathryn Thompson, Josh Pigeon, Marlise Kostiw and Tanysha Van Hecke as municipal inspectors under the <i>Agricultural Pests Act</i> and the <i>Weed Control Act</i> .			
Report	 Weed and pest inspectors are responsible for monitoring compliance and enforcing the Weed Control Act, Agricultural Pests Act and the Sturgeon County Grass Cutting Bylaw. Municipalities are responsible for ensuring that sufficient inspectors are appointed to conduct inspection duties. Sturgeon County receives Agricultural Service Board Grant funds from the Province to contribute to eligible Agricultural Service Board Programs, which includes the costs associated with employing weed and pest inspectors. Failure to appoint sufficient municipal inspectors may result in appointment of inspectors by the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry. Al expenses incurred when the Minister appoints inspectors are recovered from the municipality. External Communication

Relevant Policy/Legislation/Practices:

- Under Section 10(1) of the Agricultural Pests Act, a municipality shall appoint sufficient number of inspectors to carry out the Act and the regulations.
- Under Section 7(1) of the Alberta Weed Control Act, a municipality shall appoint a sufficient number of inspectors to enforce and monitor compliance within the municipality.

Implication of **Administrative** Recommendation

Strategic Alignment:

This recommendation supports multiple goals under the Focus Areas of Environmental Stewardship, Planned Growth and Prosperity and Strong Local and Regional Governance within the Sturgeon County Strategic Plan.

Organizational:

Vegetation Management and Pest Control are core programs facilitated for the benefit of county residents and agricultural producers. Proactive and reactive Weed and Pest Inspections are key service levels within these programs.

The appointment of four inspectors cross-trained in the administration of both the Weed Control Act and Agricultural Pests Act allows the municipality to efficiently deliver uninterrupted service during the agricultural growing season, while maximizing physical coverage of the municipality.

Financial:

The funds necessary for the hiring of these inspectors were included in the 2019 Operating Budget. No additional resources are required.

Alternatives Considered

Council could choose not to appoint the number of inspectors required to adequately administer the Weed Control Act and Agricultural Pests Act.

Implications of **Alternatives**

Strategic Alignment:

This recommendation is not consistent with the Sturgeon County Strategic Plan Focus Areas, specifically Environmental Stewardship and Strong Local & Regional Governance.

Organizational:

If a municipality fails to appoint sufficient municipal inspectors, the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry may designate inspectors to carry out these Acts within the municipality.

Financial:

Should the Minister appoint inspectors, all expenses incurred shall be recovered from the municipality.

Follow up Action 1. Issuance of Inspector Identification, as specified by the *Weed Control Act* and Agricultural Pests Act (Agriculture Services, May 2019).
