Proposed Motion	That Council approve the Pinewood Hall Association as an Additional Named Insured under Sturgeon County's insurance policy.			
Administrative Recommendation	Administration recommends that Sturgeon County continues to show support to volunteer agencies in the County by approving the Pinewood Hall Association's request.

Report	 Background Information The Pinewood Hall Association operates and maintains the Pinewood Hall and adjacent grounds to offer the Sturgeon County rural community a place for social activities. Pinewood Hall Association is incorporated under the Societies Act of Alberta. 			
	• The Additional Named Insured Program allows the County to support the community by providing a cost effective, efficient and comprehensive insurance alternative for non-profit groups that qualify.			
	Sturgeon County Council has previously approved seventeen Additional Named Insured associations under its insurance policy to date. Each Additional Named Insured is required to enter into an agreement with Sturgeon County as the master policyholder, relating to insurance coverage requirements and minimizing risk exposures.			
	Each Additional Named Insured is responsible to pay their own insurance premiums.			
	 Any claim against an Additional Named Insured is litigated under Sturgeon County's insurance policy. 			
	Administration has been working with RMA Insurance to facilitate this request.			
	RMA Insurance reviews Additional Named Insurance requests for eligibility prior to Council decision and has determined that the Pinewood Hall Association is eligible.			
	Sturgeon County is not required for insurance purposes to have representation on the boards of each Additional Named Insured as it is acceptable to be provided with minutes of all board meetings as well as

Relevant Policy/Legislation/Practices:

Each new Additional Named Insured requires a resolution from Council approving their addition to Sturgeon County's insurance policy outlining that Council is aware of the risks and responsibilities of adding the Additional Named Insured.

Implication of Administrative Recommendation

There is administrative work required coordinating insurance invoices and managing claims for Additional Named Insured associations.

Financial:

There will be no tangible cost to the County as each Additional Named Insured is responsible for paying their insurance. A significant claim by an Additional Named Insured may impact Sturgeon County's insurance rate.

Council could decide not to approve Pinewood Hall Association as an Additional Named Insured under Sturgeon County's insurance policy.
