AMENDMENT TO BYLAW 1382/16 - EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT BYLAW

STURGEON COUNTY, MORINVILLE, ALBERTA

A BYLAW OF STURGEON COUNTY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING BYLAW 1382/16 – THE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT BYLAW.

WHEREAS, the *Municipal Government Act,* R.S.A. 2000 c.M-26, and any amendments thereto, authorizes Council to establish and amend the Emergency Management Bylaw 1386/16;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of Sturgeon County, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. Bylaw 1382/16 is amended by adding the following subsections to the Bylaw:
 - 3.6 The committee is to provide guidance and direction to the Municipal Emergency Management Agency.
 - 5.3 The Agency is responsible for the administration of the Sturgeon Regional Emergency Management plans and programs and is required to report to the Municipal Emergency Advisory Committee, a minimum of twice a year, to provide updates on Agency activities.
 - 5.4 The Parties in the Sturgeon Regional Emergency Management Partnership will utilize the command, control and coordination system commonly referred to as the Incident Command System (ICS).
 - 7.4.6 Be responsible for the administration of the Sturgeon Regional Emergency Management plans and programs and is required to report to the Regional Emergency Advisory Committee, a minimum of twice a year, to provide updates on Agency activities.
 - 7.4.7 The Sturgeon Regional Emergency Management Partnership will utilize the command, control and coordination system commonly referred to as the Incident Command System (ICS).

2. That this bylaw shall come into force upon being passed.
