Sturgeon County 2019 Municipal Census Report


The 2019 municipal census was conducted between April 15 and July 30, 2019. It is the first municipal census conducted since 2008. The goal of the 2019 municipal census was to obtain an accurate count of the County's population and to obtain demographic data about the residents who call Sturgeon County home.

For the first time, residents were able to complete their census online in addition to the option of providing information to a census worker at their door. An impressive **40%** of households chose to complete the census online, demonstrating this as an effective, convenient option for residents.

With this information, County Council and Administration can more effectively plan for the County's growth.


Approximately half of the respondents have been living in Sturgeon County more than **10** years


14% of properties are listed as bare land, unoccupied, or under construction

The largest number of new residents have relocated from Edmonton




POST-SECONDARY STUDENTS IN STURGEON






Age by Division




Prior Residence of Respondents at Residence less than 2 Years









Employment status by Gender






