## **Proclamation**

July 13, 2021

**Whereas,** nearly two decades ago, Mr. Ian MacGregor had the foresight to understand that Alberta's abundant resources will play a pivotal role in supplying growing energy demand within an environmentally conscious world.

**Whereas,** the Sturgeon Refinery and Alberta Carbon Trunk Line system have attracted the attention of the world as a symbol of the prosperous future of an energy-based economy when coupled with the capability of carbon capture.

Whereas, Mr. MacGregor's vision, leadership, and enduring resilience made the entire journey possible.
