Report	Background Information				
	• West County Hearth is a seniors' facility providing quality care for independent, supportive and assisted living within Sturgeon County.				
	 In 2013, representatives from the West Sturgeon Aging in Place Foundation made a presentation to Council requesting financial support for the West County Hearth similar to the support the County provides to the Sturgeon Foundation In 2015, through a budget information request, Council requested administration to calculate the additional amount of grant to West County Hearth required if the grant was indexed to Sturgeon Foundation's annual requisition. A similar approach was used in calculating the 2016 funding however the increase was not captured due to an error in budgeting. Administration has taken corrective action to ensure that the 2017 budget is reflective of the full amount including the increase due to indexing.
