Report	Background Information				
	 River Valley Alliance in partnership with 7 municipalities has a vision for a continuous, connected North Saskatchewan River Valley Park that spans 88 km and will be one of the largest metropolitan river valley parks in the world. ISL Engineering and Land Services was contracted to design and construct the first 1.8 km portion of Sturgeon County's Waterfront Trail The tender was posted July 27, 2016, and closed on August 12, 2016. All seven bids in response to the request for tenders were substantially over budget. A meeting was held with RVA and Alberta TrailNet Tuesday, August 30, 2016, to review the situation and make recommendations on how best to proceed based on the principles outlined in the existing agreements. Factors contributing to the cost of the trail: Topography Slope stability Canadian Association Technical standards for accessible design. RVA staff are in the process of providing us with peer review comments on the design in comparison to other RVA projects. This review was not complete prior to publishing the agenda and therefore a final recommendation has to been included at this time. 				

	 The funding agreement signed with RVA strictly identifies that: The Municipality is solely responsible for payment of costs that exceed the Total Estimated Costs Funding from Canada cannot exceed 50% of the total eligible expenditures The Municipality agrees to promptly notify the RVA in writing when the Municipality determines that there may be: Increase or decrease in costs Changes in scope Delays in achieving total Performance The Municipality shall submit requests to change scope, budge or schedule for review (Initiated verbally August 30, 2016). Potential strategies to remediate the shortfall in funding are being considered in consultation with our funding partners. There is a very high level of commitment to the shared vision. External Communication Consultation with RVA, ISL and Alberta TrailNet has occurred since the Council meeting on August 23, 2016.

Implication of Administrative Recommendation	Strategic Alignment:Strong Local Governance and Regional LeadershipHonouring and respecting the tender process supports our interest in providing consistent and accountable leadership through transparent processes. There has been a great investment in this trail, and proceeding with the right design is important regionally.
	Organizational: Working collaboratively with our partners, who are as invested as we are in this project, has been very rewarding. We have learned a lot through this process and will be prepared to participate in process improvements along with RVA.
	<u>Financial:</u> The financial implications will be better understood based on new information response from the partners.
Alternatives Considered	 Reject all proposals. Change the scope of work (length of the trail) to maximize the congruency between the budget and the bid price. Issue a post tender addendum. Request the additional funding from our partners.

Implications of	Strategic Alignment:				
Alternatives	 Any delay in construction will have a negative impact to the residents of the area. Trees have been removed to expose the trail alignment for the completion of geotechnical investigation and the <i>Historical Resources Act</i> clearance. Residents living in the area will continue to have restricted use of the trail until construction is complete. <u>Organizational:</u> Additional staff time and effort would be required to support any change in the tender process. Significant delays beyond this construction season will result in additional work for Finance at year end to record any accruals associated with carrying the project into another calendar year and an amended agreement with RVA. 				
	 Financial: It is difficult to anticipate the additional hourly costs for the consultant on the project as a result of any further delays. Price changes in construction costs are always influenced by market and may not be significantly less in a re-tender due to the uniqueness of the project. 				
Follow up Action	 Notify ISL of the decision. (Community Services, August 2016) Request an amendment to the agreement with RVA (Community Services, September 2016) Prepare letter to Alberta TrailNet articulating the situation and asking for an adjustment to their funding. (Community Services August 2016)
