	<ul> <li>The distinguished budget award is designed to ensure an entity's budge serves as a policy document, a financial plan, an operations guide and a communications device.</li> <li>2016 was the first year that Sturgeon County had submitted their consolidated budget package to GFOA (Government Finance Officers Association) for review.</li> <li>The criteria that must be fulfilled when applying for the award includes:</li> <li>Strategic Goals and Strategies</li> <li>Organizational Priorities and Issues</li> <li>Budget Overview</li> <li>Budget Transparency</li> <li>Basis for Budgeting/Budget Process</li> <li>Financial Policies</li> <li>Performance Measures</li> <li>Statistics and Supplementary Data.</li> <li>The budget is reviewed by three committee members, and a consolidated ranking is used to determine the overall score of the budget document that has been submitted.</li> <li>In 2015, only six municipalities in Alberta received the Budget award.</li> <li>To date, only five municipalities in Alberta have received the Distinguished Budget Award.</li> <li>The Distinguished Budget Award is open to municipalities, colleges, and school districts within Canada and the United States of America.</li> <li>Collaboration amongst every department was key to bringing the 2016 budget package together; however, special recognition to Financial Services, Communications, and Business Strategy is due for the success of the document.</li> </ul>
